Investing in a Common Future Against the backdrop of growing Russian-Thai trade turnover in 2024-2025, encompassing both export and import figures, a central question in bilateral business relations persists: how to ensure trust and foster mutual long-term interest between the parties amidst ongoing global changes? Currently, the largest commodity items in the trade relations between the two countries remain traditional petroleum products, metals, and fertilizers. However, more complex joint investment projects in high-tech sectors with significant added value are increasingly playing a role. This diversification of bilateral relations sends a clear signal to the business and investment community about the normalization of the investment climate. Can the model of Russian-Thai investment partnership become a blueprint for a new architecture of international investment in an era of global economic fragmentation? <p>November, 26</p> <p>12:00 - 13:30</p> <p>Main Stage</p>	<p><i>Track opening session</i></p> <p>Attraction and Protection of Investment in Phuket's Integrated Development Zones</p> <p>If a foreign investor expresses interest in large-scale development projects in Thailand, the Kingdom currently lacks legitimate and transparent instruments for capital protection. Complex conditions for purchasing or leasing land, limited opportunities for international business, difficulties with registering foreign investors and employees, as well as capital movement restrictions – all these factors create substantial barriers. However, by opening access to financing for foreign investors and developers, Thailand could establish numerous world-class recreational zones and attract significantly more international investment.</p> <p>In Russia, by contrast, effective mechanisms of cooperation between the state and investors in the construction sector have already been developed. More than 90% of real estate projects are implemented through the model of integrated territorial development (ITD) – large-scale land plots developed under a single master plan that provides for transport and pedestrian infrastructure, social facilities, unified communications, and an overall architectural concept. This has been made possible thanks to a strong regulatory framework that protects the interests of all stakeholders – financial institutions, developers, and buyers.</p>

Technological independence is becoming a key factor in competitiveness. This not only reduces vulnerability to external risks but also creates new opportunities for innovation and technology export.

This session, featuring IT, telecom, and cybersecurity industry leaders from Russia and Thailand, will discuss the benefits of developing digital sovereignty and technological resilience. We will also discuss practices that help companies reduce their dependence on external suppliers, how governments support local IT ecosystems and startups, and how joint initiatives enhance trust and investment attractiveness. The focus will be on the two countries' experiences in building digital sovereignty: defining criteria for technological maturity and cyber resilience, supporting innovation, and developing partnerships between business and government. We will discuss which cooperation scenarios can ensure sustainable growth and openness to the global market.
